8 Transport Between Hotels

Delegates will meet their own travel and accommodation costs.

We highly recommend using online taxi service (e.g., Uber and Bolt) as it is very reliable and affordable. Note that internet is required to make such bookings. All applications use cash in Kenyan Shillings.

9 Visa Requirements

9.1 How to Apply for Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA)

All foreign travellers must apply for the Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) before entering Kenya The following are the steps for applying for the eTA:

- 1. Visit https://etakenya.go.ke
- 2. Click "Apply Now" and follow the instructions.
- 3. Make sure that all the data has been entered correctly.
- 4. Submit the application.
- 5. An email confirming receipt of your application will be sent to you.
- 6. An email confirming receipt of payment, if applicable, will be sent to you.
- 7. Upon decision by Immigration officer, an email confirming Approval / Refusal will be sent to you.
- 8. If your application has been approved, please either print the PDF document that has been attached to the email, or download the document to your mobile device or save it in the "Kenya Travel Authorisation" mobile app. This is your electronic travel authorisation that needs to be shown at all departure and arrival points.
- 9. If your application has been denied, you will not be able to travel to Kenya for the moment.

Please contact support@etakenya.go.ke to report your situation and obtain further details. You can check the status of your application at any time by visiting the following URL: https://etakenya.go.ke.

Note:

1. You are only allowed to travel after your application has been approved by the Government of Kenya.



2. The eTA applications for Kenya are usually processed in 3 days and there is an urgent processing service, however, it is recommended applications be submitted at least 2 weeks prior to travel to ensure adequate time for processing.

9.2 Exemptions from obtaining the Electronic Travel Authorisation (eTA)

In accordance with the KENYA CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION (AMMENDEMENT) RULES, 2025, the following persons are exempted from obtaining the Electronic Travel Authorisation (eTA):

- a) Holders of Kenya Permanent Residence, valid Work Permits and Passes.
- b) All persons whose passports are endorsed with valid Kenya reentry passes or any other written authority in lieu of a re-entry pass.
- c) **Citizens of the East African Partner States**: These countries include Burundi, Democratic Republic of Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania and Uganda for a period not exceeding 180 days.
- d) Nationals of the following Countries for a period **not exceeding ninety (90) days**:
 - Barbados Grenada Papua New Guinea The Bahamas Belize Union of Comoros The Gambia Guyana Botswana Jamaica Samoa Tonga Brunei Kiribati San Marino Trinidad and Tobago Cyprus Lesotho Sierra Leone The Republic of Dominica Malaysia Singapore Congo South Africa Eritrea Maldives Tuvalu Eswatini Malawi St. Kitts and Navis Vanuatu Ethiopia Mauritius St. Lucia Zambia
- e) Nationals of the following African countries for a period **not exceeding sixty (60) days**:

Monetary Fund and World Bank, Inter-Governmental Authority on Development (IGAD), African Airlines Travel Association (IATA), Environment Liaison Centre International (ELCI), of Union of Radio, Television Network of Africa (URTNA), International Labour Organization (ILO), Preferential Trade Area/Common Market of East & Southern African Bank European Union, CIP (International Potato Centre), African Reinsurance Corporation (ARC), African Housing Fund (AHF), African Export – Import Bank (Afreximbank) Laissez - Passers whilst on official business of the respective organizations.

- g) Holders of Diplomatic and Service Passports from The Islamic Republic of Iran and Republic of China for a period not exceeding (30) Days stay.
- h) Holders of Diplomatic, Official, Special, and Service Passports, from The Republic of Turkey, Brazil, india and members of their families holding valid Diplomatic, Official, Special, and Service Passports, while on Transit or Stay not exceeding ninety (90) days.
- i) Serving Members of the British Military.

All delegates are responsible for obtaining their own visas and meeting requirements for entry into Kenya.

10 Health requirements

10.1 Yellow fever vaccination certificate

Countries that require Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate for all travellers older than 9 months or 1 year:

All travellers arriving in Kenya from countries where yellow fever is endemic should present a valid yellow fever certificate.

10.2 Yellow Fever Vaccination exemptions

- **Infants aged less than 9 months**, except during an epidemic when infants aged 6-9 months, in areas where the risk of infection is high, should also receive the vaccine.
- **Pregnant women** except during a yellow fever outbreak when the risk of infection is high.
- People with severe allergies to egg protein.
- People with severe immunodeficiency due to symptomatic HIV/AIDS or other causes, or who have a thymus disorder.

10.3 COVID-19 Requirements

All travellers arriving into the country through any point of entry **shall no longer be required to show proof of either COVID-19 vaccination**; or a pre-departure COVID-19 test.

Only travellers arriving at any point of entry into Kenya with flu-like symptoms will be expected to fill the passenger locator form on the 'jitenge' platform. They will also be required to take a COVID-19 antigen test upon arrival at their own cost. Those who turn positive for the antigen testing will be required to take a further COVID-19 PCR test at their own cost. Those with severe symptoms shall thereafter be allowed to isolate as per the prevailing isolation requirements for mild, moderate and severe disease.

11 Time

Kenya is located in the East African Time Zone (UTC +03:00).

12 Electricity Supply

The Kenyan electricity supply is between 220 and 240 volts AC. Most plugs type G, which is the plug that has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern.

Acceptance of Visa, MasterCard is almost universal for retailing and most services, including supermarkets, accommodation and departmental stores. There are cash dispensing machines (ATMs) conveniently located and easily accessible.

15 Weather

During this period weather in Mombasa is likely to be wet as this marks the beginning of the rainy season. Daytime temperatures are expected to be around 30-31°C (\approx 86–87 °F) while the nighttime lows tend to be about 23–32 °C (\approx 75–77 °F). Thus, this tends to feel quite warm and muggy especially in the evenings and early mornings.
